ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

All chapters of Alpha Phi Omega in good standing - as defined by the National Bylaws - may apply for the Youth Service Grant. No chapter may receive an award more than twice in five years. The maximum grant per chapter is \$500. A chapter may submit only one application for one project or program, per grant year.

WHAT IS THE APO YOUTH SERVICE GRANT PROGRAM?

The APO Youth Service Grant Program provides funds, in the form of a grant, to Alpha Phi Omega chapters for pro-active service to youth. Each year, grants are awarded to qualifying chapters to conduct a service project that relates to socially positive programs for pre-college-age youth. The Alpha Phi Omega Endowment Trust facilitates the funding for this unique program. The APO Youth Service Grant Review Committee evaluates the applications and funds as many appropriate projects as available monies will allow. Grants range from \$100 to \$500 each. The National Office will notify all chapters submitting applications when selections have been determined.

PHILOSOPHY

We seek solutions to help improve difficult situations youth sometimes face. Quite often in our communities, we will react to young people who have been negatively affected by societal problems. The APO Youth Service Grant Program is based on a different premise: to create positive outreach programs, or to support existing programs that address the root social issues. The goal is to help mold the young people of today positively before they are affected by negative factors. Examples of this type of project include mentoring programs for youth at risk and skill training programs (art, sports, etc.) at youth centers.
