

ALPHA PHI OMEGA John Mack Scholarship

The John Mack Scholarship is a financial award for members that exhibit leadership and participation in extracurricular activities to benefit charitable or humanitarian organizations, or more simply – organizations in need. Recipients of the John Mack Scholarship are awarded funding to put toward their educational expenses at their current university. Expected awards are a one-time scholarship of at least \$1,000 per recipient.

All applications are to be submitted through the APO website and received by the National Office for processing before the John Mack Scholarship Review Committee reviews applications for approval or denial. When applying, members must meet the requirements below:

- Be a member of Alpha Phi Omega National Service Fraternity and have been initiated before July 2020.
- **2.** Be enrolled at a college or university for the upcoming school year.
- **3.** Be pursuing classes leading to a college or university degree.
- **4.** Exhibit volunteerism and unselfish service to others.
- **5.** Exhibit significant participation and leadership in extracurricular activities to benefit individuals in need and/ or charitable and/or humanitarian organizations
- **6.** Submit a John Mack Scholarship Application with a statement of purpose of education and career plans.
- **7.** Submit a letter of recommendation from a chapter advisor or another volunteer leader.
