- 2012 Rolex Awards for Enterprise Laureate- He works on health challenges in poor communities in Kenya

- He is an alumni of Ohio University and a ford foundation scholar.
- An expert in communication development, health communication, democratic governance and research.



His Achievements

- Founded the first ever Telemedicine center in Kenya
- Rehabilitated criminals through sports engagements
- Mobilized over 2900 women with high risk pregnancies in the slums where he is giving them maternal and child health education
