THIS GUIDE DEFINES (AND DEPICTS) THE STEPS REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT MODULE SURVEYS

Module Evaluations are designed to support a structure where one set of questions is asked about the overall Course or an Event AND a separate set of questions is asked about the specific instructors, speakers, or booths (where a trade show might be the overall topic). There is no physical limit to the number of Questionnaires which may be combined into the "booklet" nor is there a limit to the number of Instructor/Courses or Presenter/Events.

Once Generated, all of the questions for the Module Survey will appear contiguously in the sequence defined when the Module is created.

IN GENERAL, THE STEPS INCLUDE:

- Activate the appropriate System Setting
- Create 2 (or more) Questionnaires:
 - Overall Course/Event Questions (asked once)
 - Individual Instructor/Speaker/Module Questions (repeated)
- Add the Instructors/Speakers/Facilitators who will be evaluated and will receive their specific results via email from Class Climate
- Define Course Types and Associating a specific Questionnaire to each
- Add the "Overall Module (Course) Name" to a SubUnit
- Add the "Courses" (Individual Component Names to the Overall Module
- OR Import Base Module and Components via CSV or XML
- Generate the Survey
- Take the Survey Hardcopy, Online or Hybrid (Cover Sheet is not supported)
- Display the Reports

MODULES MAY BE ADDED USING THE FOLLOWING METHODOLOGIES:

<u>Manually</u>, via the User Interface (Similar to adding Instructors or Presenters)

<u>Imported</u> Using .csv Format (Excel Spreadsheet, Saved As file type = "comma separated values")


<u>Imported</u> using XML Format (Provides additional capabilities not supported by .csv format; i.e., Creating New SubUnit(s), Establishing Scheduled Tasks, Loading Participants, etc.)

THE NAMING CONVENTION USED IN THIS DOCUMENT:


Overall Name of the Module = Driver Education (DE101)

ACTIVATING MODULES

Log-in to Class Climate as an Administrator or Secondary Administrator Choose System Settings Select "Central Evaluation" from the Settings pull-down



Near the bottom of the page, you will find the settings for Module. This must be 'Activated' for this function to be enabled.




Click 'SAVE' at the bottom of the screen.



CREATING THE QUESTIONNAIRE(S)


This process is unchanged.


For this exercise there will be two (2) questionnaires:
One will contain the questions for the overall course/event
The other will contain the questions for the individual Instructor/Speaker/Booth



Each Questionnaire will be linked to a specific Course Type.

Note: You may create as many Questionnaires for a Module as required.






Scenario: Evaluating a Conference using three (3) unique Questionnaires:

- #1 Used to evaluate the venue/facility (to provide a report for the Conference Organizer)
 - Q1. Did you stay at this hotel?
 - Q2. How would you rate the overall registration process?
- #2 Used to evaluate each speaker (to provide individual reports for each speaker)
 - Q1. The speaker was well prepared
 - Q2. The speaker knew the subject well
- #3 Used to evaluate the overall Conference (to provide a report to the Conference Organizer and each speaker, if desired)
 - Q1. The conference was worth the time invested
 - Q2. I plan on attending next year

LINKING QUESTIONNAIRES TO COURSE TYPES


The Module process involves linking the Course Types to specific Questionnaires. From the System Setting Tab, choose Course Types.

You may use existing Course Types. The system will only use the linked Questionnaire when Generating a Module Survey.



MANUALLY CREATING A NEW MODULE USING THE USER INTERFACE


MODULES MAY BE CREATED IN ANY SUBUNIT



ADDING THE MODULES AND COMPONENTS (SUB-MODULES) TO BE EVALUATED

The Module Name and Course/Event Name are added to the SubUnit.

Note the Name of the Base Course is: [Drivers Education] and the sections of this course will be added to this Base Course




The Base Course is automatically created.

Click the [1] in the CO Column

Components (Courses) will now be added to the Module much in the way Courses are added to Instructors.

The Base Course may be edited by clicking the Action: "Pencil"




Click 'Add Course' to add the first Component to this course.

ADDING THE SUB-MODULES TO BE EVALUATED, CONT.


Enter all the information about the first element of your Module. For this example, it will be Overall Course Evaluation.

After entering the overall "Course" for your Module, you will enter each piece to be evaluated.



ADDING THE SUB-MODULES TO BE EVALUATED, CONT.

Enter all the information about the subsequent elements to be evaluated.




NOTES:

By including the Name of the Instructor with the Course ID, the Report Creator will be able to see this entry and combine with other statistics when creating Compilation of Instructor reports

Be sure to choose the appropriate Questionnaire/Course ID combination for the questions desired in this portion of the Questionnaire.

To insure the Instructor receives their portion of the Evaluation, include them as a Secondary Instructor.

Enter the remaining two sub-modules and identify the specific Instructors / Speakers / Booths. When you have completed all components of the Module, your screen should appear as follows:




The sequence of the entries for the Questionnaire may be adjusted by moving the Components "up" / "down", by clicking the appropriate orange arrow.

GENERATING A MODULE SURVEY

The Generate process is slightly different from non-Module Surveys.

After choosing Generate Surveys from the SubUnits Tab, the following appears:



Choose the appropriate deployment method and click Generate Survey.


The following Survey appears.



This Questionnaire will be initially stored in the Archive Folder of the person who generated this Survey. It may be relocated to any existing Folder.

VIEWING THE MODULE SURVEY

The following preview is the Online Module Survey. Because the Questionnaires were designated "Chapter" Presentation, each section is on its own page. The respondents will simply click "next" to navigate through the survey.

VIEWING THE MODULE REPORTS

Choose Display Surveys from the SubUnit Navigation Bar. Choose the appropriate Module to be displayed:

"Drivers Education" will include the information for all 4 Sub-Modules.



Overall Course Evaluation will include just the information about the Overall Course.

Instructors will only contain only the individual results.

NOTE: For the Overall Course Evaluation, you may include Juan, Donna, and Carlos as Secondary Instructors so they can receive the Overall Report as well.
