Proposal Format

Lead Presenter: Provide complete contact information for the program's lead presenter including name, institutional affiliation, primary mailing address, phone number, and primary email address. Please include curriculum vitae as well.

Co-Presenter(s): Provide complete contact information for each co-presenter including name, institutional affiliation, primary mailing address, phone number, and primary email address. Please include a curriculum vitae as well.

Program Title: Your title should accurately describe the focus of your presentation.

Program Summary: In 50 words or less describe your presentation. This will be the description used in the conference program.

Program Description: Provide a 200 word description (max) synopsis of your program that includes the following:

- summary of the information, technique, theory, or research to be presented;
- the type of presentation (lecture, round table discussion, etc); and
- a description of any accompanying audio-visual materials including handouts, reference lists, etc.

Program Objectives: Provide objectives of the presentation.

Conference Theme: Briefly describe how your presentation fits with this year's conference theme "**Promoting Counselor Excellence through Professional Collaboration.**" In addition, indicate which of the following category your presentation will address:

- Counselor Education
- Clinical Practice
- Supervision

Programs will be offered in time slots of 60 minutes in length.
