

## POSITION: Clinical Instructor

The Department of Rehabilitation at The University of Texas-Pan American (UTPA) seeks applications for a non-tenure track Clinical Instructor position (HR Reference 500.0368) due to growth in student enrollment in existing degree programs and establishment of a doctoral degree program.

UTPA is located in Edinburg, Texas, 15 miles from the Texas/Mexico border and one-hour away from tropical South Padre Island. UTPA is a comprehensive regional university with an enrollment of 18,000 students. The Department of Rehabilitation has BS, MS (CORE accredited) and Ph.D. degree programs and has two undergraduate specialty tracks in the area of Addiction Studies and Concentration in Services to Individuals who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing. Currently, the Department has 15 full-time faculty positions with 12 tenured or tenure track faculty. The Department also has \$4 million in U.S. Department of Education grants including six long-term training grants.

QUALIFICATIONS: Required: (1) Master of Science in Rehabilitation Counseling; (2) a minimum of 3 years post-master's work experience as rehabilitation professional with at least 2 years in direct client service in rehabilitation settings; (3) experience in counselor and/or counselor intern supervision, and (4) CRC or CRC eligible.

Preferred for the position: (1) ABD or doctoral degree in Rehabilitation Counseling or Rehabilitation Psychology; (2) Licensed Professional Counselor in Texas or Licensed Chemical Dependency Counselor in Texas with a Master of Science in Rehabilitation Counseling degree; and (3) CRC or CRC eligible. The preferred professional experience includes: (1) experience in counselor and counselor intern supervision; (2) experience in managing a direct service clinic; and (3) 5 years work experience as a rehabilitation professional in direct client service in rehabilitation settings.

DUTIES: The primary responsibility of this position will be to teach the field experience courses including internship and practicum in both the undergraduate and master's programs. This position may teach academic courses. Additional duties include managing and supervising student placements, developing new clinical affiliation sites, and maintaining positive relationships with current sites.
