ARCA will be sponsoring student presentations at the ACA 2011 Conference and Exposition, March 23-27, 2011. ARCA will invite proposals for sessions that focus on effective strategies and innovations in education, research, practice and policy as it relates to the rehabilitation counseling profession. This includes; but is not limited to, the impact of technology (communication and social networking), programs, evaluation, and practices.

Presenters of accepted proposals should plan their presentations for a total of 25 minutes, with 5 additional minutes devoted to questions and answers. To initiate dialogue and increase networking opportunities each accepted presentation will be paired with another presentation of similar topic and assigned to a 75-minute session time slot. Following both presentations, both presenters will lead a 15 minute discussion around the topic of the session. This format will generate critical dialogue among all participants, leading to sound ideas and practices for the rehabilitation counseling profession.
