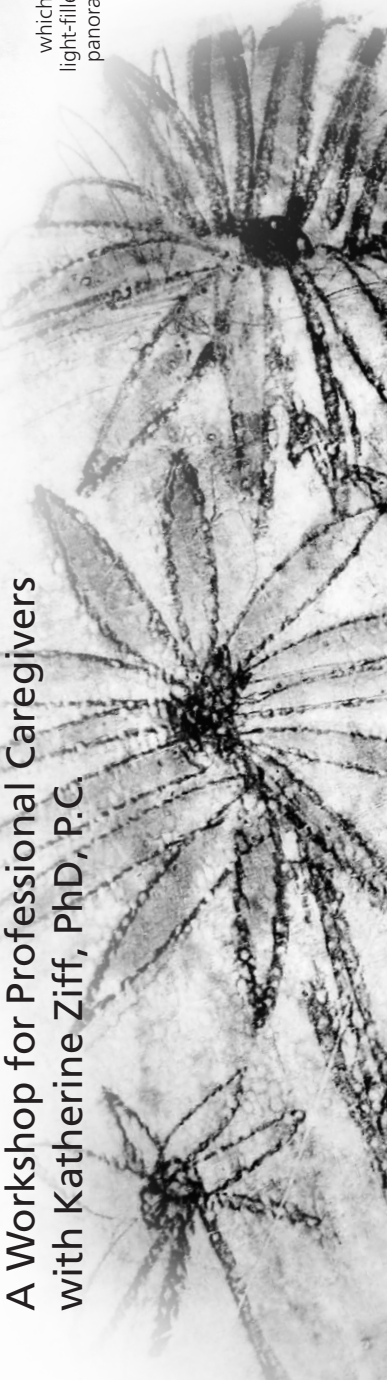

What is TOUCH DRAWING?

An expressive arts technique, Touch Drawing is done with the hands to make marks on paper placed over a surface of paint. The resulting impressions are seen on the other side of the paper as lines flowing directly from the fingertips.

Touch Drawing is used therapeutically as an adjunct to psychotherapy; for coping with grief, loss, and chronic illness; processing trauma; stress management; recovery from depression, spiritual practice, hospice patients and families; stroke survivors; and to support pregnancy. In schools Touch Drawing supports social/emotional needs of children and children with special needs. For more information about the technique see www.touchdrawing.com.
