- (F) The board shall adopt any rules necessary for the committee to implement this section, including criteria for the committee to use in determining whether an applicant's training should be accepted and supervised experience approved, and including a rule that:
- (1) Requires that a graduate degree in counseling that is obtained after January 1, 2018 at an Ohio mental health counseling program, in order to meet the requirements of division (B)(2) of this section is from an institution accredited by the council for accreditation of counseling and related educational programs (CACREP) in clinical mental health counseling or addiction counseling and other eounseling accreditation programs approved by the Board; and
- (2) Stipulates that CACREP accredited programs in clinical mental health counseling, <u>addiction</u> <u>counseling</u>, and, until January 1, 2018, mental health counseling, <u>addiction counseling</u>, and any other program area approved by the board by rule are deemed to have met the licensure educational requirements of division (B)(3) of this section; <u>and</u>
- (3)Establishes course content requirements for qualifying counseling degrees from out of state counseling programs that are not CACREP accredited clinical mental health or addiction counseling programs and for those with graduate degrees accredited by other counseling accreditation programs recognized by the Board.
- (4) Rules adopted under this division shall be adopted in accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code.

- (1) Requires that a graduate degree in counseling that is obtained after January 1, 2018 at an Ohio mental health counseling program that is obtained after January 1, 2018, in order to meet the requirements of division (B)(2) of this section is from an institution accredited by the council for accreditation of counseling and related educational programs (CACREP)(2) Stipulates that CACREP accredited programs in clinical mental health counseling and, until January 1, 2018, mental health counseling, and any other CACREP accredited program counseling accreditation program area approved by the board by rule; and
- (2) Establishes that individuals that have a graduate degree in clinical mental health counseling from a CACREP accredited program are deemed to have met the licensure educational requirements of division (B)(3) of this section-; and
- (3) Establishes requirements for qualifying counseling degrees from out of state counseling programs that are not approved under paragraph (1) of this Division or non CACREP accredited, which are from appropriately accredited institutions recognized by the Board.
