The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry, Office of Vocational Rehabilitation (OVR), is the Designated State Unit (DSU) responsible for assisting Pennsylvanians with disabilities in obtaining, maintaining and retaining competitive integrated employment. OVR's mission is to assist Pennsylvanians with disabilities to secure and maintain employment and independence. Since 1919, Pennsylvania has provided rehabilitation services to thousands of people with disabilities as a legal right and public service.

Though OVR is not a large state agency, with just over a 1100 staff; last year, OVR provided services to 72,475 individuals with disabilities and placed approximately 8,438 individuals in competitive integrated employment opportunities.

Services are provided through five (5) program areas including:

- The Bureau of Vocational Rehabilitation Services (BVRS) with fifteen (15) district offices statewide and 700 staff
- The Bureau of Blindness and Visual Services (BBVS), with six
 (6) district offices statewide and
 165 staff
- The Bureau of Central
 Operations (BCO), providing administrative, budget, contracts and grant support to the field bureaus with forty (40) staff
- The Hiram G. Andrews Center (HGAC), a comprehensive training center located in Johnstown, PA with 200 staff,

 The Office for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing (ODHH), comprised of five (5) staff
