## **EXPECTATIONS**

- ✓ Be available for seminar work activities and training on the tasks you will be performing Thursday, September 19, 2019 and Friday, September 20, 2019, beginning at 8:00 a.m. Please keep in mind this is an all day event starting as early as 7:30 a.m. and concluding at 5:30 p.m.
- ✓ Upon arrival, you will need to check in at the Registration area. A specific person and arrival time expectation will be identified in your confirmation email. It is critical you arrive on time in order to allow for activities and training.
- ✓ Participate in activities as assigned at the Certification table, Registration table, and in session as a Monitor.
- ✓ Student Ambassadors are responsible for all transportation costs to and from the training facility (parking is free). You are encouraged to ride share with others from your area.
- ✓ Prior to leaving the conference or immediately afterwards, you are to submit an article for the INTERCHANGE, ORA's membership newsletter and our e-newsletter. The article should highlight your experiences as a Student Ambassador.
