5. WHAT IS YOUR FAVORITE QUOTE FROM A BOOK OR A LINE FROM YOUR FAVORITE MOVIE?

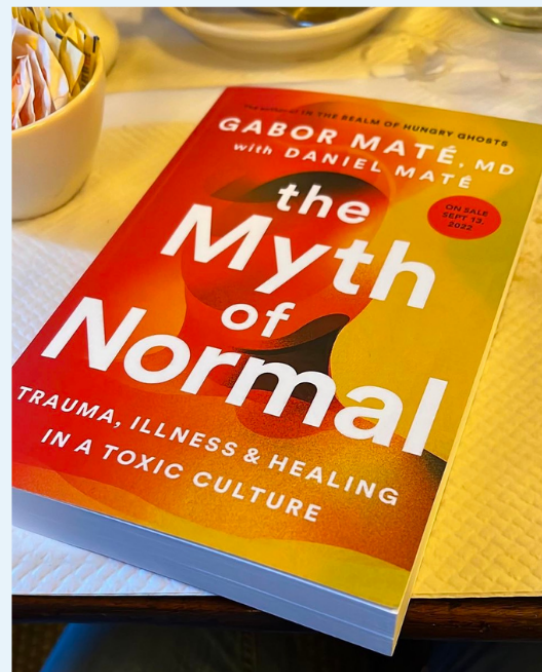
