CAMPUS SUICIDE PREVENTION: CREATING A CAMPUS SAFETY NET

There's increasing concern about the mental health of college students, and suicide is the second leading cause of death for the college-age population. This presentation will focus on the key components of campus suicide prevention. A practical example of suicide prevention at Nova Southeastern University (NSU) Florida where Dr. Poland, a licensed psychologist and an internationally recognized expert on school safety, youth suicide, and school crisis prevention/intervention, serves as a Professor of Psychology and the Director of the Suicide and Violence Prevention will be shared. He has presented on suicide prevention more than 2000 times in every state and many foreign countries and is known for his practical presentations. He also authored the Suicide Safer School Plan for the state of Texas, the Crisis Action School Toolkit-Suicide for the state of Montana and the Florida STEPS School Toolkit for Educators to Prevent Suicide.
