Clinical Rehabilitation and Mental Health Counseling (**CRMHC**)

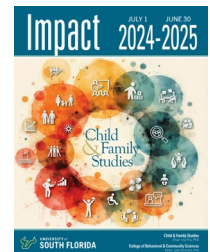
