The Convention consists of one delegate from each undergraduate chapter that is in good standing with Fraternity. Each undergraduate chapter selects its delegate to the Convention; provided that such delegate shall be an Undergraduate Member of the Fraternity and that Chapter. The Convention has full power to adopt, amend and repeal the Fraternity's Laws and to do all things necessary and proper to carry out the operations and to effect the purpose of the Fraternity. All undergraduate members are encouraged to attend the Convention.

THE ASSEMBLY OF TRUSTEES

The Assembly of Trustees is a formation of one Trustee from each Alumni Chapter of a related Undergraduate Chapter that is in good standing with the Fraternity. Each Alumni Chapter selects its delegate to the Assembly of Trustees; provided that such delegate shall be an Alumni Member of the Fraternity and that Alumni Chapter. The Assembly of Trustees has full power to adopt, amend and repeal the Fraternity's Laws and to do all things necessary and proper to carry out the operations and to effect the purpose of the Fraternity. All alumni members are encouraged to the attend the Assembly of Trustees.

AWARDS LUNCHEON

During the luncheon, the fraternity will recognize the following:


