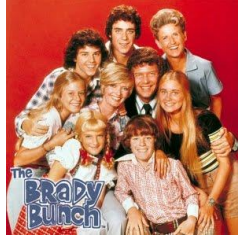

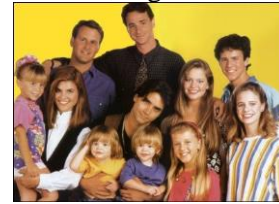

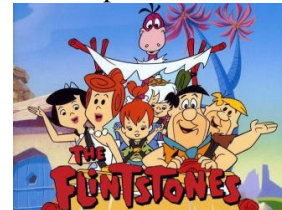

Homecoming Rules

General Rules:

1. Only undergraduate, active and new members on the current, fall semester chapter roster are eligible to participate in Homecoming events.
2. Compliance with all federal, state, local, and Ohio University laws regarding alcoholic beverages and drugs must be followed. Any violation of these rules will be considered a violation of Homecoming rules. Use of alcohol or illegal drugs prior to or during any Homecoming event is grounds for disqualification.
3. If **any** member of a team (from any of the four councils) is intoxicated during any Homecoming event, the entire team will be immediately disqualified from the event. A second offense will lead to the entire team's disqualification from participating in Homecoming week 2014.
 1. Individuals found to be intoxicated will be referred to the office of Community Standards & Student Responsibility and their inter/national headquarters and/or advisors will be contacted.
4. All members participate in the events at their own risk.
5. Each chapter is responsible for selecting a delegate to represent the chapter at weekly delegate meetings (beginning on September 16th). Failure to attend weekly meetings will result in a 10 point deduction from their team's overall score.
6. **NO CHEATING!** This is self-explanatory...hold your members accountable!

Disputes and Controversies

1. In the case of a dispute or controversy, team delegates have **24 hours** after the event ends to submit a discrepancy form (found at the end of this packet) to a member of the homecoming planning committee (see front cover). Forms submitted past this time period will be disregarded.
2. Only the designated team delegates are to communicate concerns with the Homecoming Committee. Please advise chapter members to communicate through their delegate. Thus, your delegate should be someone who can communicate professionally even in times of stress.
3. Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in the reduction of a team's standing in Homecoming Week. This includes but is not limited to:
 1. Harassment
 2. Damage
 3. Fighting
 4. Inappropriate communication with Greek Life Office staff, Planning Committee, or Homecoming Committee
4. Disqualification from an event or the entire Homecoming Week can result from breaking any of the previously stated rules. Decisions regarding disqualification are up to the discretion of the Greek Life Office Staff.

REMEMBER!! Homecoming is about having FUN and is a friendly competition. Overall, we are representing the Greek community at Ohio University. Please keep this in mind throughout the week! :)

Homecoming Week Event Attendance

For Homecoming Week events that count for attendance points, members of the Homecoming Committee will be at the events with sign-in sheets. Each team will have a designated committee member to sign in with. Teams will receive points for how many members they have in attendance. Team members will be able to begin signing in **30 minutes before each event**. Unless stated otherwise, sign-ins will end at the time an event is scheduled to begin. Team members who arrive past the time the event begins will not be able to sign in for attendance points.

At sign in, team members must have their OHIO ID to verify their name and PID number. A team member can only sign their own name. If a team member is found signing another name or leaving an event early, **their attendance point will not count for the team.**

Final attendance scores will be calculated based on the percentage of team that comes to each event. This will be based upon the chapter's roster currently on file in the Greek Life Office.

Delegate attendance to weekly Homecoming Committee meetings will also factor into the teams' overall score on attendance. A delegate **from each chapter, on each team** must come to every delegate meeting. If not all delegates from a team are in attendance, the team will suffer a **10 point reduction** from their overall score for each absence.

Events that count for attendance points:

- Flag football: Monday, October 6
- Greeks Give Back service event: Wednesday, October 8
- Yell like Hell: Friday, October 11

T-Shirt Fundraiser

As a part of the community service event of Homecoming Week, we as a Greek community will be fundraising for Athens County Food Pantry. The homecoming planning committee has designed a “Greeks Give Back” t-shirt for each team to order. For every shirt ordered, a team will earn 5 points. A long sleeve shirt option will also be available to earn a team 8 points for each order. 10% of the total sales will be donated to the food pantry through the “Pack the Pantry” event.

Teams may begin ordering shirts **Wednesday, September 17th**. A link to order will be emailed out to the team delegates.

The order will close on Monday, September 29th. When ordering shirts, please fill your team name in the “Organization Name” category. Orders without team name in this section will not be counted. If an order’s payment does not go through upon closing of the order, that order will not go through nor count.

To maximize orders (and points earned) per team, send shirt link to family members and chapter alumni!

All members of the Greek Community will be encouraged to wear their shirts on Wednesday of Homecoming Week (October 8th) at the community service event. Let’s show campus how we are a united Greek community doing good things for our school!

Rules

The Flag Football Tournament will consist of a 7 on 7 game between teams with 3 women and 4 men on the field at all times. Official game rules and regulations will be announced at the beginning of the tournament. Intramural referees will be monitoring the games; however, it is an expectation that teams will conduct a fair game without need for an official. Unsportsmanlike behavior will result in a deduction of points (under discretion of Homecoming Planning Committee) as well as potential disqualification from the Flag Football Tournament.

Game Play/ Scoring

In the interest of time and logistics, two teams will be awarded 5th place points and three teams will be awarded 6th place points. See attached sheet for further details, bracket placement was determined at the first homecoming delegate meeting.

Attendance

All must enter through GATE 4. Attendance will be counted for the Flag Football Tournament, and homecoming committee members will be present from 6:30 pm – 7:30 pm. Attendees may leave once their team is eliminated.

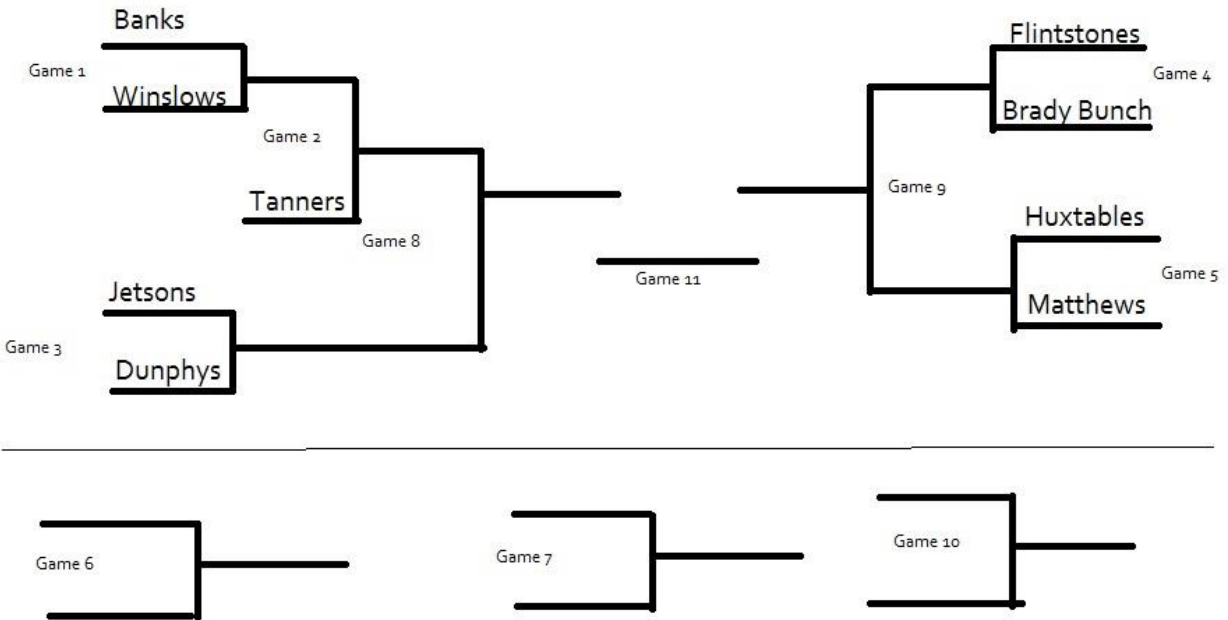

Family Feud

Date: Tuesday, October 7th 2014

Time: 6:00 PM - 8:00 PM (Attendance begins at 5:30)

Location: Nelson Banquet Hall

The homecoming planning committee will be surveying the Ohio University community for the most popular responses to given OU themed prompts. Each team will be responsible for nominating 5 team members to represent their “family” in a game of Family Feud! Team members are encouraged, but not required, to take on character of their given family!

Each team must have 50 people in attendance to watch as the audience. Due to limited space in venue, no more than 50 team members may attend per team.

Each team will play a single round on their own. After all 9 teams play a round, the 5 teams with the least amount of points will be eliminated from the competition. The team with the most amount of points will then play three rounds of questions against the team with the 3rd most amount of points (stealing questions will now be possible!). Then, the team with the 2nd most amount of points will play the team with the 4th most amount of points. The winners from each of these games will go head to head in a final 3 rounds! In the event of a tie between teams during any of these steps throughout the game, the tied teams will nominate one member to produce the most points for the same given question. The winning team will proceed participating in the outlined competition.

Pack the Pantry

Teams will be encourage to participate in the Student Alumni Board's "Pack the Pantry" event to benefit the Athens Food Pantry. The funds used from your "Greeks Give Back" t-shirt orders will be used towards this competition, which accounts for 50% of the score. Based on the funds you have raised through the t-shirt orders, this will correlate to the number of cans the food pantry can purchase for distribution (\$250 = 1,000 cans).

At Ping front lawn during the designated hours, teams will be encouraged to participate in a can castle competition using cans that the Student Alumni Board will provide for construction. Teams will be judged on the following criteria: 50% of score is related to funds raise, 30% of score is on Athens/OU-themed can castle design, 20% of team score on OU spirit.

Teams will attend the annual Yell Like Hell Pep Rally hosted by Student Alumni Board. Hosted by the Student Alumni Board and the OU Alumni Association, this year's pep rally and bonfire will feature fireworks, a live DJ, performances by OHIO groups, the 2014 Homecoming court, and greetings from President McDavis. The first 1,000 attendees will receive a free cup and hot chocolate or apple cider.

Like years past, teams will also be responsible for designing and ordering a homecoming sweatshirt to be judged at the Pep Rally. Each team must have a representative arrive at 8:30 wearing their homecoming sweatshirt. The Student Alumni Board will judge each team's sweatshirt and declare a first, second, and third place winner! Sweatshirt designs must be approved in advance by the Greek Life Office, and designs are due to Baker 330 by 9/30/2014 by 5:00 pm

Homecoming Parade & Banner/Float Competition

Teams have the choice of creating either a banner or a float for the annual Homecoming parade. Floats will be worth more points than banners, but will be judged in the same ranking (there is not a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place for floats and a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place for banners). Whichever one your team chooses, at least 10 members (5 men and 5 women) must walk/drive with the banner/float. 10 points will be deducted for every member under 10 participating. For each additional member on the team walking in the parade, 10 points will be added per person (only up to 100 points). Floats and banners will be judged by the official parade judges.

Your float or banner must use elements of the homecoming theme “Bobcat Family Reunion,” and include your team name and have the letters of each organization on your team. Team delegate must register their team for the parade at <http://www.ohio.edu/homecoming/parade.cfm>, attend the Parade Orientation meeting, and follow all requirements in the Homecoming Parade guidelines

Any member walking/driving in the parade found to be intoxicated will disqualify their team from the event and the team will not be eligible to participate in the parade.
