WHERE CAN I SUBMIT MY RESUME FOR REVIEW?

DO POSITIONS WITH THE TEST ENGINEERING GROUP REQUIRE A DEGREE?

Yes. The 412th Test Wing, Edwards Air Force Base hires engineering B.S. and M.S. graduates to work as flight test engineers to test and evaluate both manned and unmanned aircraft.

IS U.S. CITIZENSHIP REQUIRED ?

WHAT TYPES OF TUITION ASSISTANCE ARE AVAILABLE?

There are several options for tuition assistance available for DoD civil service employees. High education is encouraged for expanding on technical expertise and career growth opportunities. The two major tuition assistance programs used by engineers at the AFTC are described below.

Long Term Full Time (LFTT) Tuition Assistance - Tuition assistance offered via the AFTC Education Office in which the member is able to attend graduate school full time while maintaining salary and benefits.

Science and Engineering Career Field Team Tuition Assistance (SECFT-TA) - Offered by the Air Force Personnel Center, covers 100% tuition assistance for graduate level education obtained outside of normal work hours.
