We spend little time preparing students for aspects of their careers that involve the review and development of curriculum, peer evaluation and promotion, and participation in shared governance in one's department, college, university, and profession. The panel will involve brief presentations from four faculty about this aspect of their careers, but most of the time will be available for questions and discussion.
