EECS Graduate Teaching Assistant Application Process – Fall 2026

Beginning Fall 2026, the EECS Department will use a revised Teaching Assistant (TA) screening and selection process. All interested and eligible EECS graduate students must complete the full application process. Only applicants who complete all required steps and meet the eligibility criteria will be considered for Fall 2026 TA appointments.

Eligibility

EECS graduate students must satisfy **all seven** of the following requirements to be eligible for a Fall 2026 TA appointment:

1. Maintain active OU graduate student status and be enrolled in residential an **MS Thesis** or **PhD** program. Students enrolled in the **online MS program** or **MS Non-Thesis** program are **not eligible** for TA.
2. Have an overall GPA of at least 3.25/4.0 and have earned no less than a grade of B in the course they will TA.
3. Have no active holds on their graduate record.
4. Have an approved Program of Study (PoS) on file.
5. Have no unapproved delays in completing PoS milestones, as defined by the MS or PhD program guidelines.
6. Not hold a Research Assistant (RA) appointment during the TA term.
7. Have an **Ohio University-approved English proficiency level** that permits appointment as a TA. Applicants must meet one of the following: (1) be a native English speaker, or (2) demonstrate English Language Proficiency requirements, more info can be found here [English Language Proficiency Requirements | Ohio University](#).

All interested and qualified EECS graduate students must complete **every required step**. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Step 1: Complete TA Training

- Enroll in and complete the EECS Teaching Assistant Training Course on Canvas:

- Achieve **100% on all module quizzes**.
- Verify your scores in the **TRAINING_EECS_TA_2025** → **Grades** section.
- Applications with less than 100% overall quiz scores will be rejected without further notice.

Step 2: Complete the Application Form

- Answer **all questions** listed in **Table 1** of the TA Application Form (see below).

Step 3: Submit the Application

- **Deadline: July 31, 2026**

Appointment Decisions

- Decisions will be announced as soon as possible. Some TA appointments may not be finalized until beginning of the fall term or later because of budget availability, course enrollment and/or departmental needs.
