

Tenure-Track/ Tenured Positions In Computer Science



The Department of Computer Science at the Illinois Institute of Technology invites applications for multiple tenure-track/tenured faculty positions at all ranks. Appointments to start in Fall 2020.

Applicants must have a Ph.D. in computer science or a closely related field, demonstrated excellence in research, a record of attracting external research funding, and a strong commitment to teaching. Outstanding candidates in all areas of computer science are encouraged to apply, especially candidates in cybersecurity, data science, artificial intelligence, parallel and distributed systems, and programming languages.

Illinois Institute of Technology, a private, technology-focused research university, is located just 10 minutes from downtown Chicago. A recently completed capital campaign has led to the creation of multiple endowed positions, the Center for Active Computational Thinking, and the new Ed Kaplan Family Institute for Innovation and Tech Entrepreneurship.
