



The Clermont County Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) is currently seeking qualified candidates for the position of GIS Analyst 1. Clermont County is a growing community on the east side of Cincinnati that contains suburban, rural, and historic communities with a range of planning needs. With a diverse and growing economic base, the county is fiscally stable and actively engaged in promoting economic development to increase the tax base and provide employment opportunities for residents.

As a result of merging two departments in 2011, the DCED contains several related disciplines and functions which will provide a supportive framework and broader context in which the GIS Analyst will perform his/her duties. The DCED includes the divisions of economic development, planning, community development block grants, geographic information systems and communications. As an integral part of the department, the GIS Analyst will be responsible for the following functions:

- Development of web based mapping applications using ArcGIS Server and ArcGIS Online
- Assisting with database maintenance and software upgrades
- Planning – assist planning staff with their review/reports/presentations for subdivisions, rezoning, township zoning resolution amendments by preparing relevant presentation quality maps
- Public Requests – wide variety of requests from citizens or other government entities for GIS information, including both printed maps as well as requests for GIS data
- Small Communities Assistance – assist any of Clermont County’s 14 townships and 11 villages with their GIS needs
- Local/Regional Engagement – Ohio Kentucky Indiana Council of Governments, Middle East Fork Balanced Growth Project, Ohio Valley Regional Development Commission, Agenda for the Future, etc.

This is a terrific position for someone wanting to be engaged in a wide variety of activities, and definitely requires an organized self-starter who enjoys keeping up with rapidly changing GIS software technology.

Starting salary range is \$43,555 - \$55,099, depending upon experience and qualifications.
