City Planner I or II

Bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year college or university in Urban Planning, Urban Design, Architecture, Landscape Architecture or related field; Master's degree preferred; and,

Three to five years of progressively responsible related experience; or,

Any combination of education, training and experience which provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities to perform the essential functions of the job.
