- Open to students pursuing a degree in civil engineering, geographic information systems, geography, planning, urban studies, or a related field.
- Basic knowledge of GIS Software.
- Must be able to perform assigned field work, walking and climbing on uneven terrain. Will work indoors and outdoors in all-weather including heat and cold conditions.
