Community health | Public policy | Public relations & communication | Research and evaluation

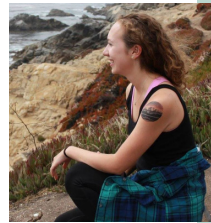
### Eligibility Requirements
