Description of Research

Research Questions

- 3. What does the limited research on this population tell us about them, in an effort to encourage more empirical research on international students and to identify what has and has not been studied?

- □ Find the key information such as keywords, themes, demographic information of the subjects, theories, research methods, data collection methods, and instruments used in each article
- □ Add the information to the online database using Google Form
- □ Meet with the Principal Investigator once a week to check the progress.
