

Ohio University-Chillicothe will host its 15th annual Advanced Placement Summer Institute July 28 – 31, 2014. The Advanced Placement Summer Institute introduces the teaching methods, student exam expectations, and curriculum content needed by teachers of AP® courses for high school students.

AP English Language & Composition

The AP Summer Institute in English Language and Composition will provide intensive training to teachers and prospective teachers of AP English Language and Composition. Participants will design sample syllabi and lessons, review the AP Language exam, and practice evaluating and scoring sample tests. They will explore various critical reading strategies and through hands-on writing and review of student writing, analyze rhetorical devices, explore effective strategies for teaching the essay, and construct course units that integrate reading and writing. Participants will be expected to exchange classroom strategies and to work on syllabi for their own AP courses.

AP European History

This institute in European History is designed for new and experienced AP European History teachers. The institute will focus on: pupil selection; teacher qualifications; course content and organization; selecting textbooks; primary and secondary source readers, and reference materials; nature and parameters of the AP exam; methods of AP assessment – introduction and practice with the AP grading rubric; using visual prompts to promote higher order thinking; effective essay writing techniques; and Internet resources for the instruction and research. The instructor will discuss how to prepare students for the 2014 exam as well as forthcoming changes to the AP European History course and exam in 2015-16.
