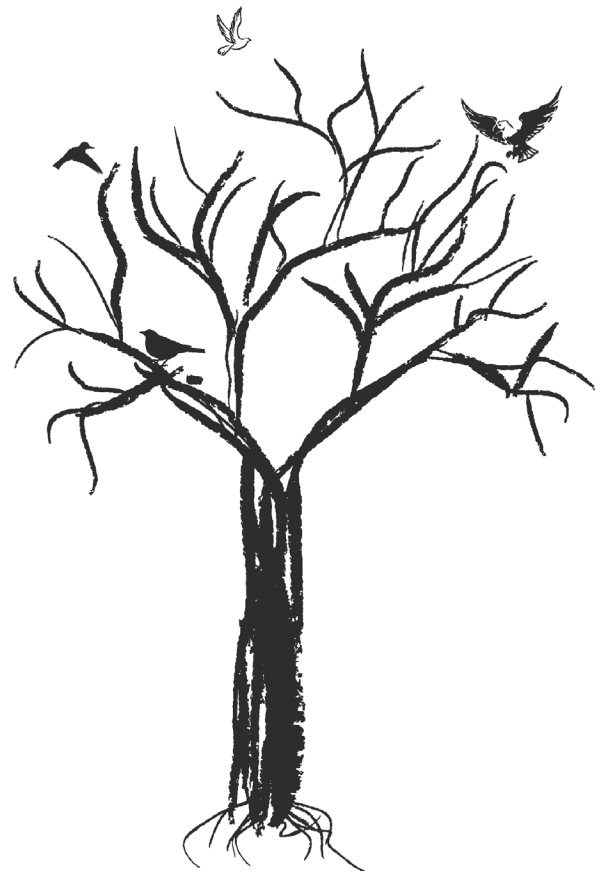

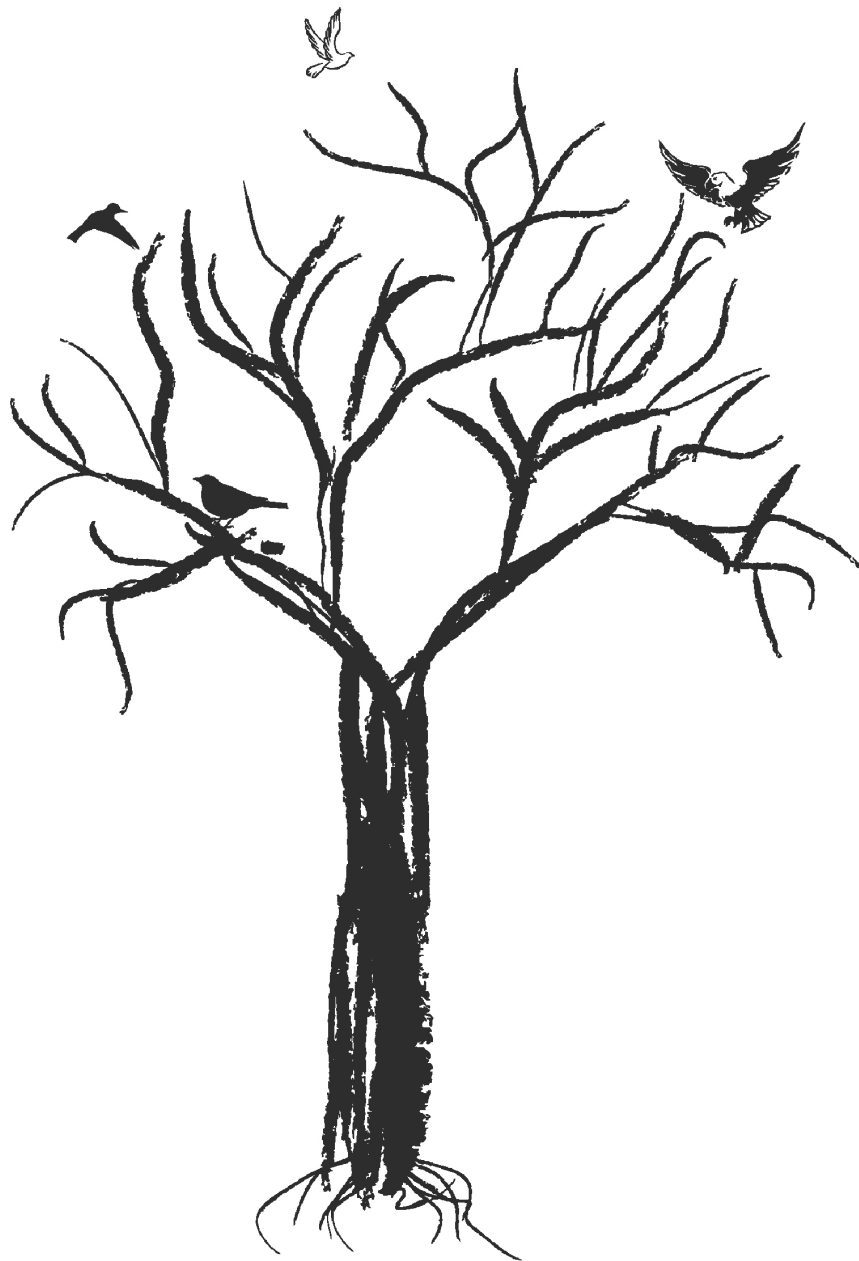
Donations and Volunteers Needed for Tree Plantings!
