Salt Fork Lodge and Conference Center 14755 Cadiz Road, Lore City, OH 43755 Salt Fork Lodge is located off US 22 East. East of Cambridge, Ohio Approximately 15 minutes to the lodge from the park entrance.

<u>CINCINNATI</u>: Interstate 71 North to Columbus. Then follow directions from Columbus.

<u>CLEVELAND</u>: Interstate 77 South to U.S. route 22 East (Cambridge Exit 47). Turn left onto U.S. Route 22 and go six miles to the park entrance.

<u>COLUMBUS</u>: Interstate 70 East to Interstate 77 North. Follow Salt fork signs to U.S. Route 22 East (Cambridge Exit 47). Turn right onto U.S. Route 22 and follow six miles to the park entrance.

TOLEDO: Interstate 75 south to Route 30 East. In Canton, take Interstate 77 South to U.S. Route 22 East (Cambridge Exit 47). Turn left onto U.S. Route 22 and follow six miles to the park entrance.

YOUNGSTOWN: Interstate 76 West to Interstate 77 South to U.S. Route 22 East (Cambridge Exit 47). Turn left onto U.S. Route 22 and follow six miles to the park entrance.

The landscape of rural Guernsey County appears as a patchwork of forested hills, open meadows and misty valleys threaded by numerous streams. At the heart of this region is Salt Fork State Park, encompassing the woodlands and fields flanking Salt Fork Reservoir. As Ohio's largest state park, Salt Fork boasts 17,229 acres of recreational facilities to suit nearly every taste.

Reservations may be made by calling (740) 435-9000. Mention OAFCS to receive a special room rate of just \$90 per night. Deadline for special room rate is February 21, 2013. The room rate is extended to all Meeting Attendees for Thursday, Friday and Saturday night. Bring your family, you will have plenty of time for a little weekend get-a-way.

Details of the park can be found at http:www.dnr.state.oh.us/parks/saltfork. Reservations can be made from this site, but to get our special rate a phone call would be best. This site lists information about the lodge, cottages (pets permitted in some) golfing, fishing, trails, winter recreation, area attractions, Nature of the area, and History of the area.

The lodge features include a dining room, coffee shop, snack bar, gift shop, lounge and lobby areas, indoor game area, plus indoor swimming pool and sauna. The park boasts 14 hiking trails ranging from easy to moderate, and from .1 to 2 miles in length.

Area attractions include: Hopalong Cassidy Museum, Cambridge Glass, The Wilds, John & Annie Glenn Historic Site (Home and School) and the National Road Museum. A short driving distance takes you to Amish country with cheese factories, restaurants, Amish farm tours and lots of Amish buggies and folks. Roscoe Village, Shoenbrunn Village State Memorial, and Guernsey County Museum are just a few of the other attractions available.
