Proposal Description:

Abstracts (100 words) for presentations and posters are being requested for topics relating to Family and Consumer Sciences with priority given to those that relate to the meeting theme and the resolutions.

Format

- 1 Presentations will be 1 hour sessions and include one or more presenters.
- 2 Poster presentations must fit on a 4'x 8' display board and must be attended by presenters during the designated presentation period (Friday afternoon).

Proposals should include proposed session title, 100-word abstract, presentation format (1 or 2 hour concurrent session or poster presentation), potential audience, and any audio-visual equipment you plan to use for your presentation. Presenters should furnish their own Attached to this document should be one of the two information sheets below.

Guidelines for Submission Of Proposals:
