Did you know that we have prairie plants in Athens County?

Strouds Run State Park is home to three small prairie-like openings that host grassland species. Persistence of this unusual community may be threatened by encroachment of trees and shrubs that can shade out herbaceous plants. We will be thinning out woody seedlings to prevent them from damaging populations of prairie species.
