### Instructions for Submitting Abstracts

#### DEADLINE

Deadline for abstract submission is October 20, 2018 for oral presentations and November 15, 2018 for posters.

#### CONTENT

Abstracts should include:

1. Problem studied or hypothesis tested - state why you conducted your study and the importance of your research
2. Results - focus on the most important results of your study, while briefly explaining the methods used in data collection
3. Implications - explain how the results of this study will advance the understanding of fish and wildlife conservation/management

#### FORMAT

1. Please indicate if you are submitting a paper or a poster. This year we are offering two types of contributed talks: a 10 minute research or management update and a 20 minute full research talk. Update talks should describe research in progress or species status assessments, whereas the full research talks should describe completed wildlife research projects. **Also, please indicate if you are willing to display a poster, if your paper is not accepted.**
2. Abstracts should be <300 words in length, excluding title (<15 words in length) and author information.
3. Include the name, affiliation, email, and mailing address of each author. An asterisk should follow the presenting author's name.
4. Use hard returns between the title, author information, and the abstract text.
5. Italicize scientific names.
6. Please use single spacing, Times New Roman font, size 12 font, and save it in a version of Microsoft Word 2010.

#### SUBMISSION

1. Abstract submission via email is preferred. Send abstract as an attachment in Microsoft Word to **Nick.Schell@oh.usda.gov**.
2. Abstracts may also be submitted on a CD in the above format.
3. The Conference Program Committee reserves the right to edit abstracts for grammar and typesetting.
