MASTER'S IN CURRICULUM & INSTRUCTION

This online program is designed for practicing teachers and educators who have already earned a bachelor's degree and have a teaching license/certificate in any content area and age/grade band level. Teachers entering the program will advance their knowledge, skills, and dispositions in instruction, curriculum design, and evaluation. Coursework and research are centered around each student's own classroom or nontraditional educational settings and focus on innovations in teaching, student learning, curriculum development, pedagogy, assessment, mentoring, and community involvement. The program can be completed in 14 months and is aligned with the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards.

MASTER'S IN READING

This online program can be completed in three semesters. The faculty within this advanced master's program help licensed teachers further their knowledge and understanding of language and reading development, teach reading across grades K-12, administer reading assessments and make data-driven decisions, work with other teachers and specialists to design appropriate reading instruction to meet the needs of all students, and develop and conduct original research to further their own learning. Upon graduation, students are also eligible to apply to have the reading endorsement added to their Ohio teaching license.

MASTER'S IN COMPUTER EDUCATION & TECH

The Master's in Computer Education and Technology program provides students with the knowledge, skill, and experiences to perform successfully as leaders in computer education and technology-related fields. Students with licensure also may choose to obtain a multi-age endorsement. The underlying philosophy of the CET program is that computers and technology should be integrated into the total process of training, teaching and learning at all levels, including K-12, community colleges, business, and higher education. This fully online program is nationally recognized by the International Society for Technology in Education.

MASTER'S IN SPECIAL EDUCATION

This online program results in licensure in the following areas: Intervention Specialist for Mild-to-Moderate Educational needs (K-12), Intervention Specialist for Moderate-to-Intensive Educational needs (K-12), or Early Childhood Intervention Specialist (ages 3-8). Each program meets the Ohio teacher licensure requirements and is also available to those NOT holding a teaching license at the undergraduate level. The focus of the Special Education program centers on the delivery of quality services within limited resource environments.
