Dr. Benjamin has appeared on many television and radio programs, including: The Today Show, CNN, The Colbert Report and National Public Radio. He has been profiled in national newspapers including The New York Times, the Los Angeles Times and USA Today, and magazines including Scientific American, Discover, Omni, Esquire, People, Wired and Reader's Digest. Dr. Benjamin received a standing ovation when he presented part of his show at the TED 2005 meeting and since the talk went online, it has been viewed over four million times.
