Workshop 1: Basic Draping, 3 days -Learn the fundamentals of draping through draping the basic bodice and skirt along with draping manipulations to see possibilities through variations of darts and fullness.

Workshop 2: Industry use of Draping Techniques: 2 days with visits to design studios and presentation of a guest speaker on the importance of draping.

Workshop 3: Introduction to Advanced Draping, 3 days- Learn how to drape a strapless foundation and how to drape on the bias.

Workshop 4: Creative Approach to Fit through Draping, 2 days - Using basic knowledge of draping and the shape of the figure, learn how you can create fit through alternative seams to make beautiful untraditional garment.
