HISTORY:

The Order of Omega was founded at the University of Miami in the fall of 1959 by a group of outstanding fraternity men. They felt that individuals in the Greek community should be recognized for their service to the fraternity system and the University. The Order of Omega honors society represents only the top 3% of Greeks on Campus. There are now over 500 chapters in the United States with more than 200,000 alumni. The Zeta Gamma chapter was founded here at Ohio University in the fall of 1984.

PURPOSE:

- To recognize those fraternity men and women who have attained a high standard of leadership in inter-Greek activities, to encourage them to continue along this line, and to inspire others to strive for similar conspicuous attainment
- To bring together outstanding fraternity men and women to create an organization that will help to mold the sentiment of the institution on questions of local and intercollegiate fraternity affairs
- To bring together members of the faculty, alumni, and student members of the institution's fraternities and sororities on a basis of mutual interest, understanding and helpfulness

RESPONSIBILITES:

All initiated members are required to attend bi-weekly meetings and participate in Order of Omega sponsored events. There are several opportunities to lead event planning and to take on leadership positions in the organization.
