



## Scholarship General Directions

1. Application package **must** be postmarked **on or before February 1, 2019**.
2. All requested documents must accompany the application, not be sent separately.
3. All fields in the application form must be completed electronically with the exception of the Chapter Advisor's signature. It may be E-signed OR printed and signed on the hard copy.
4. Applicants may apply for more than one scholarship. Only one application is necessary. Be sure to check the name(s) of all scholarships for which you apply. (See application.) *A separate application must be submitted for awards.*
5. All application documents are to be assembled in the order described below, clipped together with a paper clip, placed in a standard size **manila file folder** with tab, and then placed in a 10"x13" envelope (regular or priority envelope) for mailing.

## Application Directions

1. Complete and submit application information in the following order:
  - A. Application (**2 copies**)
  - B. Transcript(s)
  - C. Recommendations
2. Submit one official transcript from each college/university attended (*if latest transcript does not include previous information*). To be official, the Registrar of the University is requested to place the transcript in an envelope, seal it, and write his /her signature across the seal, and give (or mail) to student for inclusion in application folder.
3. Request three recommendations. To be official and confidential, each person writing a letter of recommendation should be requested to place the letter in an envelope, seal it, write his/her signature across the seal, and give to student for inclusion in the application folder.
4. Enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard. It will be returned when the application is received.

Phi U Scholarships – A variety of scholarships (see [phiu.org](http://phiu.org)) awarded as follows:

**NOTE: ALL Phi U members are majoring in “family and consumer sciences”**

**12 different scholarships:** *Each of the above named (see [phiu.org](http://phiu.org)) scholarships will be awarded to Phi U members enrolled in baccalaureate programs. Selection will be based on the applicant’s scholastic record; participation in Phi U and other collegiate activities; a statement of professional aims and goals; professional services; and recommendations. (\$500 and up)*

**Margaret Drew Alpha Scholarship** will be awarded to a Phi U member pursuing a baccalaureate degree in a field of family and consumer sciences with preference given to a dietetics or food and nutrition major. (\$500 and up)

**S. Penny Chappell Scholarship** will be awarded to a Phi U member pursuing a baccalaureate degree in fashion design and construction, textile design and development and/or textile preservation. (\$500 and up)

**Mary Weiking Franken Scholarship** will be awarded to a Phi U member working toward a baccalaureate degree in family and consumer sciences or a related area with preference given to majors in child/family or family and consumer sciences education. (\$500 and up)

**Marty Bickett Frost Scholarship** will be awarded to a Phi U member working toward a baccalaureate degree in family and consumer sciences or a related area. Cumulative GPA 3.3 minimum. (\$500 and up)

**Tommie J. Hamner Scholarship** will be awarded to a Phi U member pursuing a baccalaureate degree in family and consumer sciences or one of its related areas who has shown exemplary commitment to Phi Upsilon Omicron. (\$500 and up)

**Phyllis S. Howe Scholarships** will be awarded to Phi U members pursuing baccalaureate degrees in family and consumer sciences. Selection will be based on the applicant’s scholastic record, participation in Phi U, and professional aims and goals. **Must provide a financial statement and complete the justification statement (see application).** (up to 3 @ \$5,750 each)

**Jackman Scholarship** **Jackman Scholarship** will be awarded to a Phi U member working toward a baccalaureate degree in family and consumer sciences or a related area with preference given to majors in family and consumer science education who have shown exemplary commitment to Phi Upsilon Omicron. (\$500 and up)

**Martha Combs Jenkins Scholarship** will be awarded to a Phi U member pursuing a baccalaureate degree in family and consumer sciences or one of its related areas who has shown exemplary commitment to Phi Upsilon Omicron. (\$500 and up)

**Treva C. Kintner Scholarships** will be awarded to Phi U non-traditional students. Recipients must have completed at least half of the academic work toward a baccalaureate degree in family and consumer sciences or a related area. (\$500 and up)

**Delores M. Kluckman Scholarship** will be awarded to a Phi U member with **preference given to majors in family and consumer sciences education**. The recipient is not required to be a chapter officer. (\$500 and up)

**Susan M. Rickards Scholarship** will be awarded to a Phi U member with preference given to a student who has shown exemplary commitment to Phi Upsilon Omicron. (\$500 and up)

**Nell Bryant Robinson Scholarship** will be awarded to a Phi U member pursuing a baccalaureate degree in family and consumer sciences or a related area with **preference given to majors in dietetics or food and nutrition**. (\$500 and up)

**Margaret Jerome Sampson Scholarships** will be awarded to Phi U members pursuing baccalaureate degrees in family and consumer sciences with preference given to majors in **dietetics or food and nutrition**. Selection will be based on the applicant's scholastic record, participation in Phi U, and professional aims and goals. At least one recommendation should be from the student's Phi U chapter advisor. **Must provide a financial statement and complete the justification statement** (see application). (up to 7 @ \$5,750 each)

**Lillian P. Schoephoerster Scholarship** will be awarded to a non-traditional student who is a member of Phi U working toward a baccalaureate degree in family and consumer sciences or a related subject. Must provide a financial statement and complete the justification statement (see application) explaining the need for additional education for gainful employment and giving reasons why to be considered a viable candidate. (up to \$3,650)

**Sutherland/Purdy Scholarship** will be awarded to a Phi U member pursuing a baccalaureate degree in clothing and textiles or a related area such as apparel design or fashion merchandising. This student must have held a leadership position in her/his Phi U chapter and have earned at least a 3.0 out of 4.0 overall point average. (\$500 and up)

[Janice Cory Bullock Award](#) will be awarded annually to a non-traditional Phi U student who desires to continue education in family and consumer sciences or a related area which will enable gainful employment. (\$250 and up)

[Sarah Thorniley Phillips Leadership Award](#) will be awarded annually to Phi U undergraduate members for outstanding leadership and participation in collegiate and community programs. (\$250 and up)

[Undergraduate Karen P. Goebel Conclave Award](#) (awarded in even-numbered years) (Deadline for applications is May 1, or until awarded) Applicant must submit an article detailing the planning and fundraising projects the individual has done to attend Conclave. This award (1 for \$500) is available to Phi Upsilon Omicron members to be enrolled during the full academic year (2 semesters or 3 quarters remaining in school after Conclave).

[Lynne White Scheider Award](#) will be awarded annually to a Phi U undergraduate member for demonstrated leadership and scholarship in the area of consumer affairs, personal finance, and/or family finance. (\$250)

[Hazel Hatcher Award](#) will be awarded annually to a Phi U undergraduate member with preference given to a student who has overcome obstacles to their educational career. (\$250 and up)

[Orinne Johnson Outstanding Candle Article Award](#) will be awarded to a collegiate member who submits the best article related to the Phi Upsilon Omicron purposes for publication in the honor society's publication, *The Candle*. (\$250)

will be awarded annually to a Phi U undergraduate with preference given to family and consumer sciences education majors. (\$250)

[Sutherland/Purdy Scholarship](#) will be awarded annually to a Phi U undergraduate with preference given to family and consumer sciences education majors. (\$250)

## GRADUATE Fellowships:

*Note: Selection will be based upon applicant's scholastic record; honors and recognitions; participation in honor society, professional, community, and other organizations; scholarly work; statement of professional goals; and recommendations. Recipients must be Phi U members.*

[Candle Fellowship](#) for study leading to a master's degree in family and consumer sciences. Phi U members who are enrolled or plan to enroll in a graduate school are eligible to apply. (\$500 and up)

[Diamond Anniversary Fellowships](#) will be awarded for study at the master's or doctoral level in family and consumer sciences or a related area. The recipients must have been accepted into or currently enrolled in a graduate program. (\$500 and up)

[Founders Fellowship](#) will be awarded for advanced graduate study. The applicant must have completed at least half the credit-hour requirements toward the doctorate in some area of family and consumer sciences and have had several years of successful employment in the profession. (\$500 and up)

[Geraldine Clewell Fellowship](#) will be awarded to a student pursuing a master's degree OR a doctoral student in family and consumer sciences or a related area with preference given to a student majoring in family and consumer sciences education and who desires to teach at the elementary, secondary, college, or university level. At least one recommendation must be from the student's major advisor. (\$500 and up)

[Jean Dearth Dickerscheid Fellowship](#) will be awarded to a student pursuing a Ph.D. in family and consumer sciences or related area and has earned at least one other degree in family and consumer sciences. The applicant must intend to pursue a career in academia. (\$500 and up)

[Presidents Research Fellowship](#) will be awarded for graduate research at the master's, doctoral or post-doctoral level in family and consumer sciences or a related area. Application must include research prospectus exhibiting organization and need for the research. (\$500 and up)
