How to sign up for Mock Interview Day 10/4/10

Mock interviews will be 30 minutes in length. Students will have the option to choose which organization they would like to interview with. Be open when selecting organizations to interview with, all employers will provide valuable professional feedback.

- 1. Log on to Bobcat CareerLink
 - a. If you do not know your password, click forgot password
 - b. Enter your email address to have a new password sent to you. This typically goes to your junk/spam mailbox.
- 2. Complete your profile if you have not done so already
- 3. Upload your résumé if you have not done so already
 - a. Click on the Documents tab
 - b. Click Add New
 - c. Enter a title for your document in the label box (i.e. YourlastnameRésumé)
 - d. Choose the document type
 - e. Browse to find the correct document
 - f. Click Submit
- 4. Click jobs & internships and select Bobcat CareerLink Postings
- 5. In the keyword box, type "mock"
- 6. Select organization you would like to interview with (i.e. Mock Interview Day Cardinal Health)
- 7. Click the Apply button on the right
 - a. Select a résumé to attach
 - b. Choose a date
 - c. Choose a time
 - d. Click Submit
