Emphasis: Fraternity & Sorority Life

Denison University's Campus Leadership & Involvement Center (CLIC) is seeking Student Affairs/Higher Education Administration graduate students for a Practicum experience during Winter 2012 (with potential to extend to Spring 2012). The Practicum Student will work approximately 10 hours per week during in the Campus Leadership & Involvement Center reporting to the Associate Director.

Denison offers a four-year residential experience for its student body, comprised of approximately 2050 students. Denison's substantive residential component enhances academic achievement, personal growth, and the development of a strong campus community, all of which are hallmarks of a Denison education.

The Practicum will feature the following opportunities for professional experience:

- Shadow Associate Director at select appointments, Student Development meetings, committee meetings, etc.
- Assist in the supervision of an undergraduate paraprofessional staff member with fraternity/sorority responsibilities.
- Assist with Student Voice benchmark data analysis of our fraternity/sorority community and help to assist
 in an action plan for 2012/13 strategy planning based on that data.
- Assess the current fraternity/sorority accreditation process and awards model and propose necessary changes to current structures and processes.
- Provide logistical support during National Panhellenic Council spring formal recruitment process (deferred).
- Partake in the facilitation of one or more leadership trainings/forums for the fraternity/sorority community.
- Assist in the advisement of a fraternity/sorority council of his/her choice. Councils include: National Pan-Hellenic Council, Panhellenic Council, Interfraternity Council and Multicultural Greek Council.
- Assist in the creation of trainings/workshops that are position specific (i.e. recruitment training, operations training, etc).
- Assist in the conceptualization and execution of a values-based leadership program for fraternity/sorority leadership.
- Other administrative duties or office coverage responsibilities as assigned.

NOTE: The specific responsibilities and professional development opportunities of this practicum experience are flexible. We will do our best to match the practicum student's interests and skill sets to departmental needs, understanding that we are in a major period of transition. Office hours will be set with the supervisor.

Denison University is located in the Welsh Hills of Ohio overlooking the village of Granville approximately twenty-five miles east of Columbus. Denison is a highly selective, private liberal arts college. The practicum student must provide his or her own transportation to and from Denison. *Denison University will provide up to \$500 in mileage reimbursement for travel to this practicum site; the position is unpaid.*
